






Poll methodology

- Nationally representative survey conducted between February 21st & 24th 2008.
- 1,500 Armenian adults who voted in last week's Presidential election were interviewed face-to-face, yielding data with a margin of error of +/- 2.6% (at 95% confidence).
- The poll was commissioned by Armenia Public TV & Radio.
- The poll was designed, co-ordinated, processed, weighted and analysed by Populus.
- Fieldwork was carried out by the Armenian Sociological Association (ASA).






- Sargsyan won among every age-group. His support was the same among men as women. He did best among younger voters (59% among 18-24s, compared with 38% among over 65s).
- Ter-Petrosyan did better among men (24%) than women (17%) and slightly better among older voters (24% among over-65s) than younger ones (17% among 18-24s).
- Bagdasaryan did better among women (16%) than men (11%).


When did you make up your mind who to vote for?
